

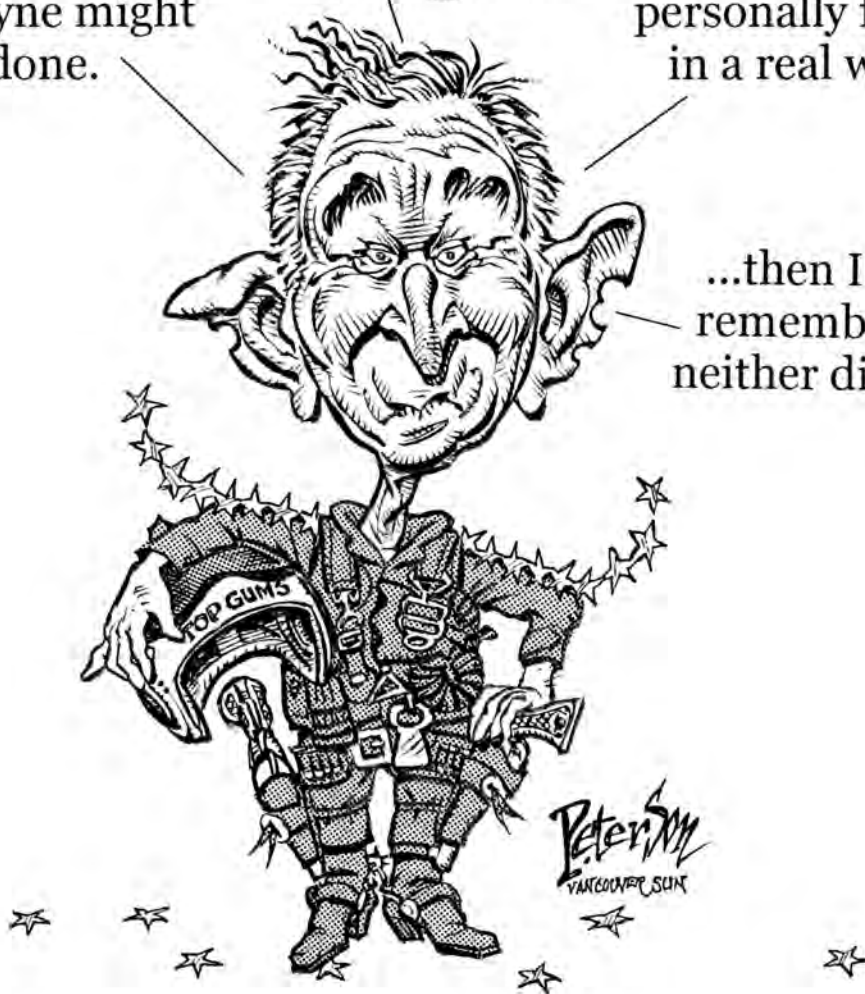

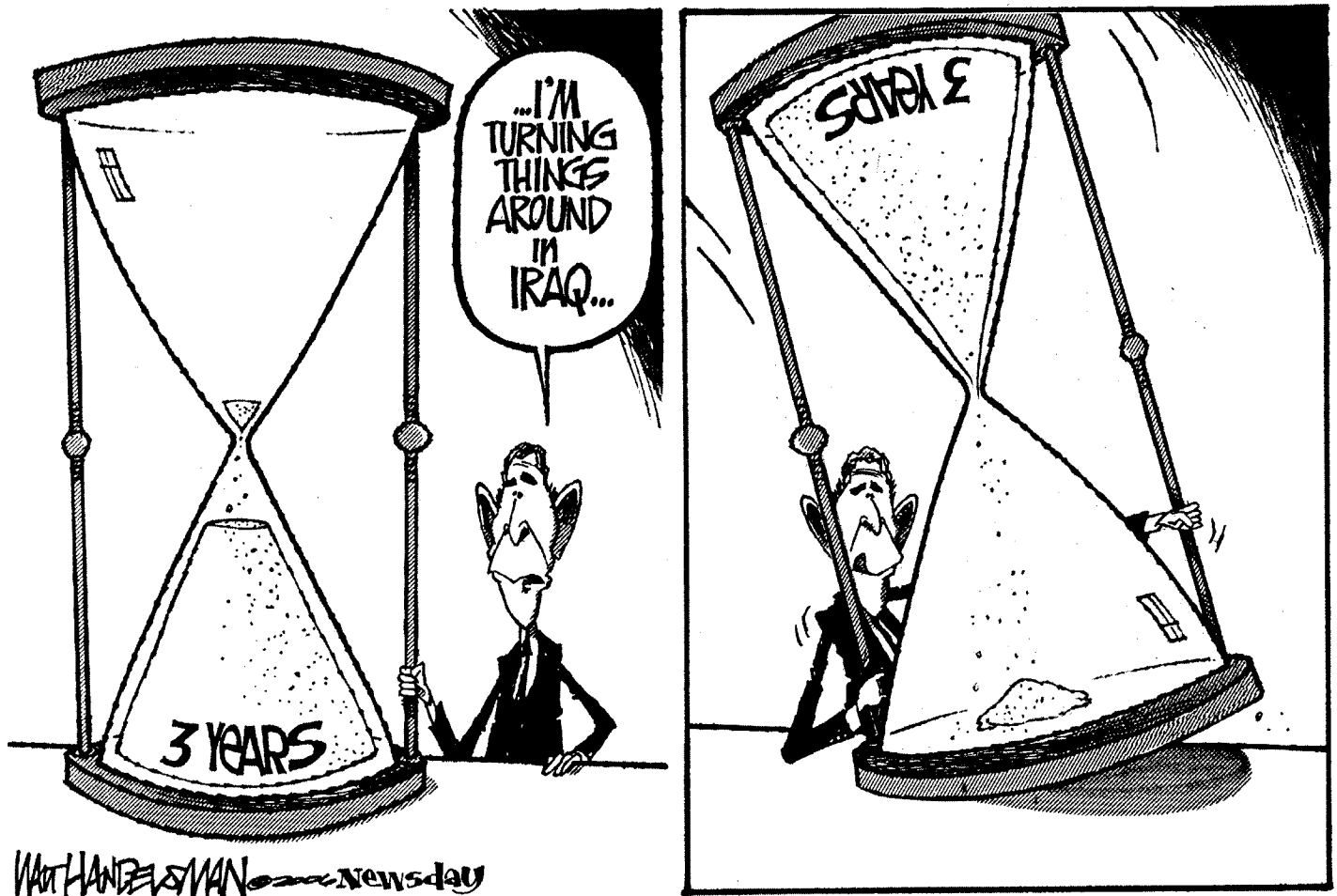

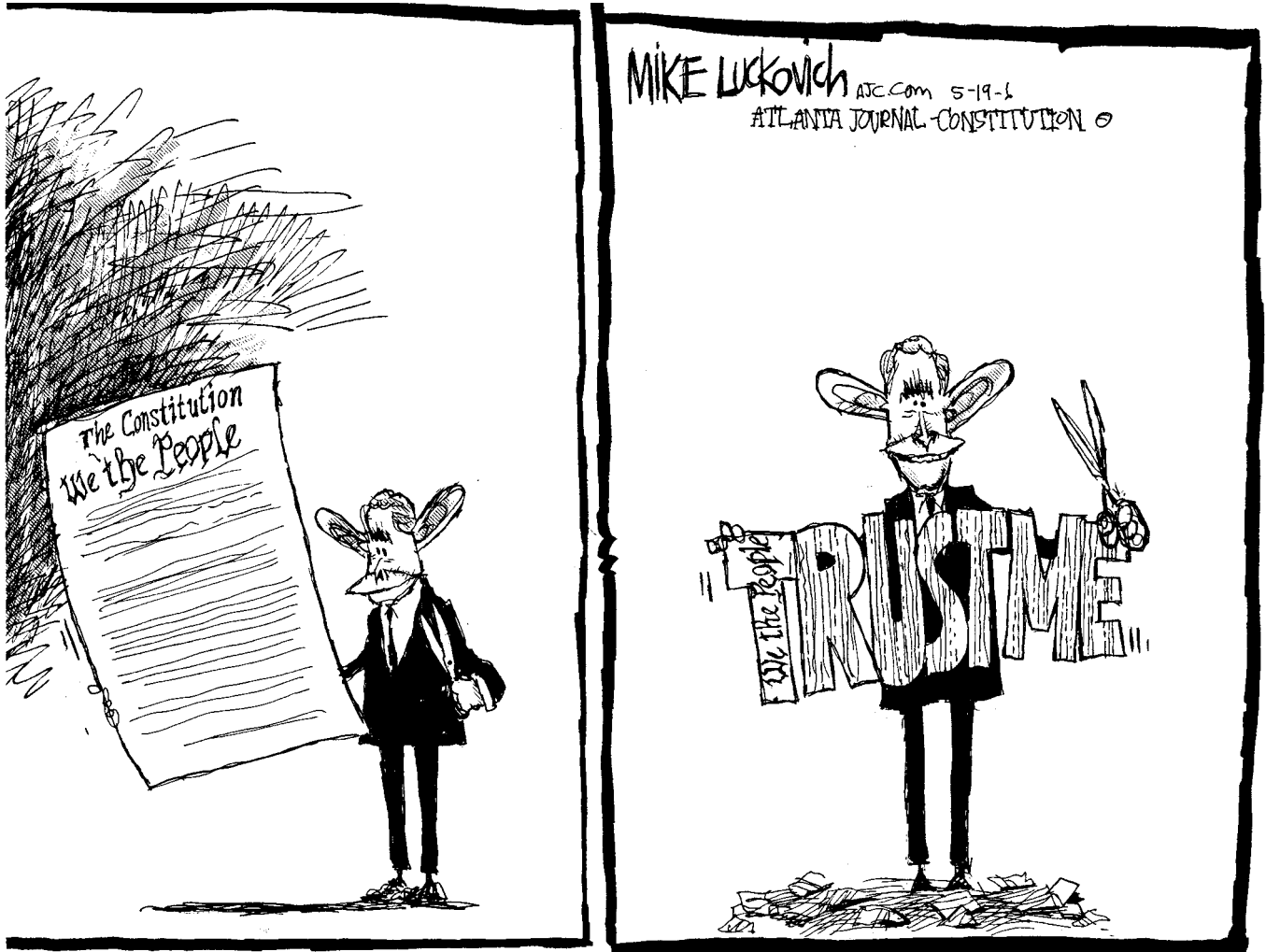


WALT HANDELSMAN
